WARRANTIES

We are so confident in our quality of work, that we are able to give you a written warranty on your restoration.

- **Fixed Prosthodontics**: Crowns and bridges are warrantied for 3 years. This warrantee includes, but not limited to, re-cementations and replacements with no additional office fee."
- **Removable Prosthodontics**: Partials and dentures are warrantied for 3 years. This warrantee includes, but not limited to, tooth breakages or clasps. Adjustments are included in the cost of the prosthetic for 6 months with no additional office fees.
- **Implants**: Warrantied for 3 years. If an implant fails, the costs associated with the placement, and if applicable the restoration, will be credited toward a re-implantation or other treatment option for tooth replacement.

• Orthodontics:

- Bonded retainers will be maintained for 3 years. During that time if the retainer comes loose or needs to be repaired, there will be no additional cost. If the lower bonded retainer is lost and needs to be replaced, there is a lab fee for replacement. After 3 years, there will be an office visit charge to re-bond the retainer each time.
- Removable retainers will be maintained for 3 years. During that time if the retainer needs to be replaced due to wear, there will be no additional cost. If the retainer is destroyed or lost however, there will be a fee to replace it. After 3 years, there will be a lab fee to replace it.
- **Avadent Dentures**: The Avadent denture was made to be a life-long denture. If you cannot wear the denture comfortably, you are encouraged to come in for any adjustments necessary for 6 months after receiving the denture at no charge. There is a 3 year warranty for any type of breakage or tooth loss—you will receive a new identical denture at no charge.

Routine dental care, including regularly scheduled cleanings, x-rays, and exams is imperative to the success of your restoration. At each visit Dr. Maltsberger and his dental team will be instructing you in proper home care and identify areas of weakness. Failure to keep you regular hygiene appointments and examinations will void the warranty on all restorative services. Failure to comply with any dental recommendations, such as wearing a night guard for the protection of restorations, or cleaning and wearing the denture as instructed could also void the warranty.

*If a tooth has had prior endodontic treatment, it must have been done in our office for the warranty on the crown to be in effect.

* After initial approval of appearance by the patient no warranty will be involved for esthetics.
